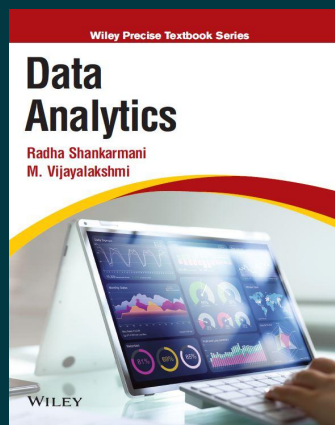




Data Analytics
